<p>Description Romans believed in many different gods and goddesses.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Can you find out who they were? • What/who did the gods look after? <p>You may want to include a glossary of new words that you have found out and used in your writing.</p>	<p>Size guidance</p> <p>A4 paper</p>	<p>Quality guidance</p> <p>You may want to present the findings from your research in different ways e.g. written work, computer print-outs, drawings or photographs.</p> <p>Remember to think of quality work rather than quantity of work.</p> <p><i>(Please no PowerPoints as we do not have the opportunity to share all of these)</i></p> <p>Have a sense of pride!</p>

2. VISIT A ROMAN PLACE OF INTEREST

<p>Description</p> <p>Enjoy finding out about the Romans gods. Write down and be ready to share some interesting facts you've learned during your visit and bring any souvenirs you'd like to share with the class e.g. maps, postcards, photographs, artefacts etc.</p>	<p>Quality Guidance</p> <p>Write down at least 5 facts that you have found out from your visit and bring in a photograph, brochure or souvenir that you got.</p> <p>You will need to be confident to share your visit with a group of children or whole class.</p>

3. CREATE A ROMAN GOD/GODDESS MASK

<p>Look into how Roman god/goddesses were represented. Try and create a mask (2D or 3D) showing that you understand how they were represented.</p> <p>Orally explain and provide a display label saying who it is and why you chose it.</p>	<p>Size Guidance</p> <p>The mask should be small - no bigger than a dinner plate</p> <p>Quality guidance</p> <p>Appropriate materials used</p> <p>Informative display label</p>
