<p>1) <u>Make a model</u></p> <p>Create a 3D model of one aspect of international physical geography that interests you. This can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · rivers · mountains · coastline · biomes (desert, rainforest, grassland) 	<p><u>Size guidance</u></p> <p>Shoebox size.</p>	<p><u>Quality guidance</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make your model bold and clear so it stands out. • Make sure that you're ready to explain the making process as well as the geography. • Try to use some materials that you would be throwing away - recycling helps the environment!
<p>2) <u>Visit a place of interest</u></p> <p>Visit a local place of interest that has some aspects of physical geography. Take some pictures and be ready to present some interesting facts you've learned from your visit. Some examples are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · The River Wandle · River Thames · Brighton beach · Merton Abbey Mills 	<p><u>Size guidance</u></p> <p>Dependent on the presentation type! Make sure it can be transported to school and kept in the classroom easily (nothing too big!).</p>	<p><u>Quality guidance</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make it as exciting as possible and use your creativity to think of a good way to present it. • Make sure that the facts you choose are very engaging. • Make sure you're ready to answer questions about what you discovered!
<p>3) <u>Research a physical area of outstanding beauty</u></p> <p>Choose a physical area of outstanding beauty in the world, and research some facts about it. For example:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · The Grand Canyon · The Alps · The Amalfi Coast · Great Barrier Reef · Yellowstone National Park · A National Park within the UK 	<p><u>Size guidance</u></p> <p>A3 max. paper size.</p>	<p><u>Quality guidance</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In your own words, rather than copying and pasting from websites. • Pictures to help us understand! Hand-drawn or printed. • Make it as exciting as possible and use your creativity to think of a good way to present it. • The quality of your work is to your usual standard or better
