Dear Parents/Carers,

At Stanley Park Junior School we aim to provide a wide range of extra curricular opportunities, many of which promote musical talents. In the spring term we 'show case' these talents, allowing those who learn a musical instrument or participate in our school choir to perform to their families and friends.

Two spring concerts are planned for the end of this term, involving the following pupils:

Years 5 and 6: Wednesday 25th March 2020 - 6:30 to 8:00pm

- Children who have been learning a musical instrument with a peripatetic teacher (either at school or in their own time)
- ALL choir members

Years 3 and 4: Wednesday 1st April 2020 - 6:30 to 8:00pm

- Children who have been learning a musical instrument with a peripatetic teacher (either at school or in their own time)
- ALL choir members
- A selection of Y4 pupils who have been learning the ukulele (Wider Opportunities)

Children who wish to **play an instrument** in the concerts should discuss what they would like to perform with their music teacher, to ensure that their teacher is satisfied with their level of competency and has given appropriate support with practising their piece. They need to indicate who they plan on performing with (as some may choose to perform in a group) and how they will be accompanied.

Choir members are asked to attend BOTH concerts so that they can perform as an entire group each time. Mrs Philips and Mrs Dixon will provide club members with a separate letter regarding these arrangements.

We are also hoping a selection of Y4 pupils will demonstrate what they have learnt during their ukulele lessons. Children already attending the Y3/4 concert will be given priority, so please indicate on the form below whether or not your child is willing to do this. We will ask individuals directly if extra performers are required.

Please complete and return the attached application form if your child would like to take part. Please also specify how many seats you require. We will do our best to accommodate everyone, but cannot guarantee more than 2 seats per performer.
