## SUMMER MUSIC CONCERTS

Dear Parents/Carers,

At Stanley Park Junior School we aim to provide a wide range of extra curricular opportunities, many of which promote musical talents. In the Summer Term we want to 'show case' these talents, allowing those who learn a musical instrument or participate in our school choir to perform to their families and friends.

Two Summer Concerts are planned, involving the following pupils:

### **Years 5 and 6: Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2022 - 6:30 to 8:00pm**

- Children who have been learning a musical instrument with a peripatetic teacher (either at school or in their own time)
- A selection of Y5 pupils who have been learning the djembe drums (Wider Opportunities)

### **Years 3 and 4: Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2022 - 6:30 to 8:00pm**

- Children who have been learning a musical instrument with a peripatetic teacher (either at school or in their own time)
- A selection of Y4 pupils who have been learning the ukulele (Wider Opportunities)

Children who wish to **play an instrument** in the concerts should discuss what they would like to perform with their music teacher, to ensure that their teacher is satisfied with their level of competency and has given appropriate support with practising their piece. They need to indicate who they plan on performing with (as some may choose to perform in a group) and how they will be accompanied.

We are also hoping a selection of Y4 and Y5 pupils will demonstrate what they have learnt during their ukulele/djembe drum lessons. Children already performing at the concerts will be given priority, so please indicate on the form overleaf whether or not your child is willing to do this. We will ask individuals directly if extra performers are required.

Please complete and return the attached application form if your child would like to take part by Monday 21<sup>st</sup> March. Please also specify how many seats you require. We will do our best to accommodate everyone, but cannot guarantee more than 2 seats per performer.
