PRIMARY BOROUGH CROSS COUNTRY TRIALS

Trials for our annual cross country competition will take place next week for children in Years 4 - 6 on the following days at 12.15pm on the school field:

Monday 25th September: Y6 boys & girls Tuesday 26th September: Y4 boys & girls Wednesday 27th September: Y5 boys & girls

The majority of trials are taking place on P.E. days for the year group, so children will not need to bring in anything specific, although please ensure that if your child would like to participate that they are wearing full P.E. kit, including suitable trainers for outdoor use. If it is not a P.E. day, children will need to bring in a pair of trainers in order to participate. The competition will consist of a 1-mile race and children will trial out this approximate distance on the school field. The fastest 8 boys and 8 girls from each year group will be selected to take part.

We know that the Wednesday trials are at the same time as the boys' football squad training. The children will do the trials first and then attend football training as usual.
