SAFEGUARDING

It has been brought to our attention by the Sutton Schools and Youth Partnership Police Officer that there are a number of large WhatsApp groups which Sutton children and young people are part of – one being over 1000+ members. Some parents have reported that inappropriate messages are being shared back and forth. I would encourage you to check your child's mobile phone regularly to help to keep your child safe online.

It has also been brought to our attention that older pupils from local secondary schools are hanging around Stanley Park Recreation Playground before and after school. Some pupils and parents have felt uncomfortable due to the nature of language being used and their behaviour. We have spoken to children in Years 5 and 6 about this before we broke up and discussed ways in which they can keep themselves safe. If your child walks to and from school please reiterate to them the importance of telling someone if something makes them feel uncomfortable and ways that they can help to keep

themselves safe.

TESCO WALLINGTON

If you go shopping into Tesco Wallington please ask for your plastic token and place it in the Stanley Park Junior School section for the cause of 'Fruit for All'. We would like all children entitled to free school meals to have free fruit at breaktimes to give them a nutritious snack to eat to keep their brains fuelled throughout the day.
