Unfortunately we have had to cancel the upcoming 'Activity Week' and 'Isle of Wight' residential trip, in line with Government advice for local and overseas trips. This is just as disappointing for staff as it will be for the children. Over the next few weeks we will issue refunds directly into your bank account for the amount already paid.

The Leavers' Book will contain a photo of each child together with their full name underneath and something they have written about themselves (they have already done this!).
