## **YEAR 3 - Geography Field Trip to Brighton**

In the Summer term, Year 3 study the city of Brighton as a contrasting locality to Carshalton Beeches. We have therefore arranged a visit to Brighton, in order to carry out some fieldwork.

During the visit, the children will use a range of methods to observe and gather information about Brighton's human and physical features, such as The Lanes, Brighton Palace Pier and the sea front. They will be encouraged to consider why people choose to live in and visit Brighton. We hope to eat our picnics on the beach.

The trip will end with a visit to the Brighton i360, giving the children the opportunity to observe the city from 138 metres in the air. We believe this will be a real highlight.

The cost of the visit will be **£21.50 per child**. This will cover the cost of the coach and the cost of the Brighton i360.

**Half of the year group will visit at a time.**

**All children in 3J and children with surnames A to F in 3P will visit on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> June 2024.**

**All children in 3S and children with surnames G to Z in 3P will visit on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2024.**

Children need to **arrive at school at the usual time of 8.40am**. We hope to **return to school by 5.00pm**.

As the day will be spent outside, please ensure your child comes well-prepared for both the worst and the best of British weather. They will need:

- To wear school PE kit, including trainers.
- A waterproof jacket and a jumper. (The children may need to sit on these when we sit on the beach, even if it is warm/dry.)
- Sun cream and a sun hat.
- A packed-lunch (nut-free items only).
- Additional snacks (for mid-morning **and** afternoon).
- A named water bottle (but no glass bottles or fizzy drinks).
- A named rucksack to keep their belongings in.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please give them their tablet/band before arriving at school.
