Year 6 trip to Honeywood Museum – 21st 22nd and 23rd November

In November, the Year 6 classes will be going to Honeywood Museum to take part in a range of Victorian Workshops using both primary and secondary sources to gain an understanding of what life was like in Carshalton during the Victorian era. This is a great opportunity for the children to further their understanding of the Victorian age in an immersive and rich learning environment. Due to restrictions on numbers at Honeywood Museum, each class will go on a separate day as follows:

6P	Wednesday 21 st November
6J	Thursday 22 nd November
6S	Friday 23 rd November

The sessions will take place at the museum from 10.30am until 2.30pm. The children will be travelling by foot, leaving at **10am** and returning at approximately **3.15pm**. The children will eat their lunch at the centre so **they will need to bring a packed lunch on the day**.

The children will need the following items which they must bring with them:

- a packed lunch in a labelled plastic bag;
- a labelled and sealed water bottle;
- an inhaler or any medical equipment necessary for individual children;
- full school uniform and a waterproof jacket.

If you would like your child to go on this visit please make your payment of **£3.00 online via Parentpay by Friday 10th November**. **By making your payment in this way you are giving consent for your child to take part.**

There are no funds available to cover the costs of pupils whose parents expect them to take part but who are unwilling or unable to contribute. However, if you have difficulty in affording the above amount, please see the Headteacher privately. If insufficient voluntary contributions are received, the visit will have to be cancelled.

This is a valuable experience that will fully support and add to your child's learning in the curriculum. Without continued parental support such trips would be unable to run. If you are able to help out with this trip, please put a note in your child's home-school book by Wednesday 8th November.
