Dear Parents/Carers,

As I am sure you will be aware, the National Education Union (NEU) is planning to take further strike action and has advised teachers to consider striking to support the union in their work to create fair funding regarding Pay and Terms and Conditions for teachers. The days for these strikes are:

- **Thursday 27th April 2023**
- **Tuesday 2nd May 2023**

I would like to thank my staff for informing me with good notice of their intentions. I am very grateful as teachers do not have to inform schools until the day of the strike.

We know that school closures inconvenience parents and carers and so I am writing to give you advance notice of the impact of the action on this school for Thursday 27th April 2023. I will be able to update you about Tuesday 2nd May early next week.

	SCHOOL WILL BE OPEN FOR PUPILS IN THESE CLASSES
THURSDAY 27th APRIL	5S and 5P - all day 6S, 6P and 6J until 1.20pm

(Parents of pupils with an EHCP, who are not in these classes, will be contacted separately to let you know if your child is able to come to school on this day)

Our breakfast club and after school clubs, which are run by external providers on Thursdays, will go ahead as normal and all children, including those whose classes are closed due to the strike, will be able to attend.

Children in Year 6 will be dismissed by staff from school at the gates at the back of the hall leading onto Glebe Path at 1.20pm. Children who already have permission to leave by themselves at the end of the school day, will be allowed to walk home at 1.20pm unless parents contact the office via email before 9am on Thursday 27th to say otherwise. 5S and 5P will be dismissed from the playground at the usual time of 3.25pm

Please note that if the industrial action does not go ahead, we will be open as usual for all pupils.

Finally, I absolutely recognise the disruption that this causes for parents and carers which is why we have wanted to provide you with this information at our earliest opportunity. I know that the decision the teachers have made is certainly not one that has been taken lightly.
