## JUBILEE DAY - THURSDAY 26<sup>TH</sup> MAY

In order to celebrate The Queen's Platinum Jubilee, SPJS will be having a **Jubilee Day** on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> May. On this day, children will be invited to come in **red, white and blue mufti** to celebrate, and we have lots of exciting events planned which we hope the children will enjoy!

### Layout of the Day

The activities for the day will consist of designing and decorating a flag, whole school singing, a quiz around the playground and a street party at 2.00pm for the whole school in the playground. For the street party, children may bring in a small plate of party food and they will be given a piece of cake to enjoy.

At the end of the day, parents are invited to come into the playground from 2.45pm where you will be able to enjoy a drink and see artwork based on the Queen's Jubilee from each class and winning cakes (see below). The children will then perform their Jubilee songs at 3.05pm. Access to the playground will be through the double gates on Glebe path.

### Design a Jubilee Card for the Queen!

As homework for the week commencing 23<sup>rd</sup> May, all children will be asked to design a jubilee card for the Queen. They can be as creative as they like to celebrate all things British and all things royal! Children will need to bring in their card on Jubilee Day, where a year group judging will be held. The card with the most votes from each class will be signed by all class members and sent to Her Majesty the Queen to congratulate her on her Platinum jubilee. All children will be given an A4-sized piece of card to complete their design on and it can be completed in any medium that the children wish.

### Cake Competition

Should children wish to enter this competition, they should decorate a cake at home (without adult help!) and bring it into school on the morning with their name under the cake board/base so it is not visible. The cakes will be judged by the children in each year group and the winner and runner-up from each class will be on display to parents who are able to attend from 2.45pm.
