Year 6 trip to Honeywood Museum – 5th October, 12th October and 19th October

In October, the Year 6 classes will be going to Honeywood Museum to take part in a range of Victorian Workshops using both primary and secondary sources to gain an understanding of what life was like in Carshalton during the Victorian era. This is a great opportunity for the children to further their understanding of the Victorian age in an immersive and rich learning environment. Due to restrictions on numbers at Honeywood Museum, each class will go on a separate day as follows:

6S	Tuesday 5 th October
6P	Tuesday 12 th October
6J	Tuesday 19 th October

The sessions will take place at the museum from approximately 10:30am until 2:30pm. The children will be travelling by foot, leaving at **10am** and returning at approximately **3:00pm**. The children will eat their lunch at the centre so **they will need to bring a packed lunch on the day**.

The children will need the following items which they must bring with them:

- a packed lunch in a labelled bag;
- a labelled water bottle;
- full school uniform and a waterproof jacket appropriate for the day's weather conditions.

As this is a local area visit we will not require parental permission, however, if you have any concerns about your child going on the trip please make an appointment to discuss these with Mr Sewell.

This is a valuable experience that will fully support and add to your child's learning in the curriculum. Please note that no payment is required by parents for this trip. **If you are able to help out with accompanying a class to and from the venue on this trip, please put a note in your child's home-school book by Friday 24th September.**
