Dear Parents,

Welcome to all our new pupils who have joined our school and it is lovely to see all our returning families. The start back has been different but I've been impressed with how quickly we have all settled into the new 'normal'.

Please can I remind all parents that if your child has any of the Covid-19 symptoms e.g. high temperature, persistent cough, loss of taste or smell, children should not come to school but be tested for Covid-19. (Please see the link on the homepage of our school website to book one). If another family member displays any of the symptoms, all children in the family should not come to school until the other person with symptoms has had a test and the results are negative. We have produced a sheet giving you information which I hope will be helpful.

If your child is self-isolating due to themselves or another family member having any of the symptoms of Covid-19, we will be setting work on Google Classroom under the classwork assignments tab and providing feedback to your child. If your child is feeling unwell whilst self-isolating they do not need to complete the work. Please let us know if this is the case. Work will be uploaded the day after we are told that your child is self-isolating.

If your child is off school because they are unwell, school work will not be provided for your child. If they are too unwell to be in school, they will be too unwell to complete any school work.

Please find attached the instructions on how to get your child to login to Google Classroom and how they can join the The Reading Shed and Thinking Shed (for their year group). Most children who attended SPJS last year have already got themselves up and running. If you are having difficulty please contact the school office and a member of staff will do our best to assist you.

New children will be invited to the individual 'classroom' for their own class.

We will also be using Google Classroom to set English homework on some occasions. This will be made clear in your child's home/school book.

Please reiterate with your child the importance of keeping safe online whilst using Google Classroom. This is particularly important for when children comment in the 'Stream' where everyone in the room/class/year group is able to see each other's comments. It would be useful to re-read page 11 and 12 of the home-school book with your child.
