Dear Parents,

As you know from previous correspondence on 8th and 15th January, we have been working on ways to increase face to face interaction. Staff have been missing seeing pupils and I know that pupils are feeling the same.

We are excited to share with you that teaching staff will be meeting with their classes on a Wednesday each week initially. We will stagger the meeting times to try and ensure that all children can participate in the meeting as many of our families share devices.

Y6 - 9.15am Y5 - 11am Y3 - 1.30 Y4 - 2.30

The purpose of the live meetings will be to give children and staff the opportunity to connect with their class community at this very strange time, to focus on well-being and celebrate achievements. During the meeting, children will have a chance to join in with discussions, play games, complete challenges and share how their week is going etc. For this reason, these sessions will not be available to watch at a later date.

Children who are currently in school will be able to view the meeting. In order to protect their privacy, they will not be shown on video as it would enable children to be identified as either vulnerable or as a child of a key worker.

In order to ensure that the sessions run as smoothly and safely as possible, it is important that you read and talk through the attached guidance with your child before the live sessions. If you are on an iPad, you may need to download the GoogleMeet App and go into settings to ensure your microphone and camera are enabled.

In order to access the Google Meet children will need to be logged into Google Classroom with their school account. The link will be on the banner at the top of the virtual classroom under the class name. When prompted, click the green 'join' button.

Children will automatically enter the Google Meet when they click on the link. If the link says that they don't have permission, you just need to check it hasn't reverted to a different google account. This is a security measure to ensure that anyone outside of SPJS does not enter.

These Google Meets must not be recorded by parents/carers or children; this is for safeguarding reasons.

We look forward to seeing as many of the children there as possible.
