Residential Trip: 11th-15th July 2022

As you are aware, children in Year 6, children have the opportunity to go on a Residential Trip. Thank you to everyone who completed our previous Google Form detailing the trip options, as a result of which our residential trip next year will be to Osmington Bay.

The trip will take place on Monday 11th July - Friday 15th July 2022. The centre is run by PGL - it is one of their largest centres, with a superb range of land and water-based activities including dragon boating, trapeze, zip wire and giant swing. Most of the activities take place on-site or in the all-weather indoor activity zone which includes a climbing wall and a large sports hall.

The residential trip forms part of our planned curriculum in physical education and personal and social education, combining the experience of a structured, residential setting with physical activities and personal and social development opportunities. Children will have a variety of activity sessions during the day in their groups and an evening activity altogether.

Travel will be by coaches leaving on the Monday morning and arriving back at school by Friday evening.

Costs have not yet been confirmed as the final amount depends on the number of children attending. This is because the coach costs have to be split by the number of people travelling. As advised, we expect the total amount to be £495. If you are entitled to Free School Meals, you will receive a discount of £100. Under the terms of the 1988 Education Reform Act we are only able to charge for board and lodgings and must ask for voluntary contributions to cover all other aspects of the visit. We must point out that there are no funds available to cover the costs for pupils whose parents expect them to take part, but who are unwilling to contribute. If you have difficulty affording the cost, please arrange to see Mrs Lamy privately in school. If insufficient voluntary contributions are received the visit might not take place.

If you would like your child to go on this trip, we require a non-refundable deposit of £45.00 (paid on Parentpay) to secure a place on the trip. As advised in the letter on 6th July the deposit is now due and must be made by Tuesday 14th September. Following this, the cost of the trip can be paid in instalments throughout the year and the

centre has full insurance in case Covid means that you cannot attend. Please see <https://www.pgl.co.uk/en-gb/book-with-confidence> for more information about this. The next instalment of £225 must be made by Friday 25th March and the final instalment of £225 by Friday 10th June.

For those children who do not attend the residential, there will be three days of activities planned, further details of which will follow in due course. These days are likely to include a visit to High Ashurst Activity Centre at Box Hill, Sutton Sports Village and a trip to London.
