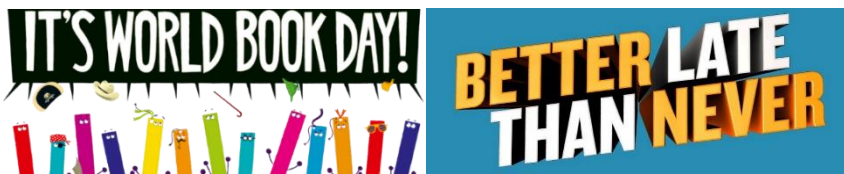

Share a story:

We will be making origami 'book marks' to encourage reviews in the library and give children a chance to recommend books to one another.

If you would like to order a signed copy, please do so by Friday 11th March 2022. Please fill out the order form, it must be returned with the correct money to school in a sealed envelope with your child's name and class on the front. Book Banquet:
