YEAR 3 BUTSER ANCIENT FARM OCTOBER 2019

We are planning a visit to **Butser Ancient Farm** on Monday 14th October 2019 as part of our study of Stone Age to Iron Age Britain. We know it will be an exciting, informative outing, where the children will learn about living as a Stone Age person.

The cost of the visit will be £21.65 per child. This will cover the coach entry into the farm and four workshops.

The coach will **depart at 8.15am** and **should return to school by 4.00pm**.
Your child needs to be at school by **8.00am**.

As lots of the activities are outside the children need to come well prepared for both the worst and the best of British weather. Depending on the weather on the day.

We recommend:

- Old clothes rather than uniform.
- Lots of layers which can be added or taken off.
- Woolly hats, thick gloves and scarves.
- Strong, old shoes or trainers are warmer than wellington boots on cold days.
- Wellington boots are good if it is very wet as it can get very muddy here.
- A bag for muddy wellington boots and a change of shoes are essential to keep the coach drivers happy.
- Warm waterproof clothing for wet and cold days. The wind can whip through the site, meaning that a thick jumper is not enough.

Your child will also need a packed lunch in a named disposable bag (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please).

We are planning a visit to the shop:

Shopping with real money is now a rare experience for many children. A visit to the shop is a useful maths activity and very enjoyable. We recommend a maximum of £2 (in a named purse or envelope) as there are many items to buy for 50p.

There are no funds available to cover the costs of pupils whose parents expect them to take part but who are unwilling or unable to contribute. However, if you have difficulty in affording the above amount, please see the Headteacher privately. If insufficient voluntary contributions are received, the visit will have to be cancelled.

If you would like your child to go on this visit please make your payment **online via Parentpay** by Wednesday 9th October 2019. By making your payment in this way you are giving consent for your child to take part.
