YEAR 5 TRIP TO GROVE PARK FOR GEOGRAPHY WORK - Friday 3rd of March 2023

This term, Year 5 will be visiting Grove Park as part of our river topic in geography. This is a great opportunity for the children to further their understanding of living things by pond dipping and exploring a natural habitat. The timings are as followed:

5J	Friday 3 rd March 2023 - 9:00pm - 12:30pm
5P	Friday 3 rd March 2023 - 12:15pm - 3:15pm

The sessions are half a day for each class. The children will be walking, leaving and returning during normal school hours. **They will need to arrive at school wearing their P.E. kit (both shorts and jogging bottoms), school jumper, trainers and a warm waterproof jacket.**

5P will need to bring a packed lunch on the day of their trip, as they will need to eat their lunch slightly earlier to enable them to arrive at the centre on time. **5J will be back in time for usual school lunches.**

The children will also need the following items:

- Wellies are preferable. (If they do not have any wellies, they can bring water shoes or shoes they do not mind getting wet plus an additional pair of trousers).
- a plastic bag, to put their wet footwear in;
- spare socks;
- small towel;

In order for our visits to go ahead, we will also require parental assistance, although we may not be able to involve all willing volunteers.
