**5S TRIPS TO GROVE PARK FOR GEOGRAPHY FIELD TRIP ON RIVERS
AND EASTER EXPERIENCE
Wednesday 1st March 2023**

On Wednesday 1st March, 5S will be visiting Grove Park as part of our river topic in geography. This is a great opportunity for the children to further their understanding of living things by pond dipping and exploring a natural habitat. They will then be walking to the Methodist church on Ruskin Road for the Easter Experience to enrich their R.E. curriculum.

The children will be leaving and returning during the normal school hours. The children will all need to bring a **packed lunch** on the day of their trip, which we will eat at the park, weather permitting.

They will need to arrive at school wearing their P.E. kit (both shorts and jogging bottoms), school jumper, trainers and a warm waterproof jacket. They will also need to bring with them:

- Wellies are preferable. (If they do not have any wellies, they can bring water shoes or shoes they do not mind getting wet plus an additional pair of trousers).
- a plastic bag, to put their footwear in;
- spare socks;
- small towel;

In order for our visits to go ahead, we will also require parental assistance, although we may not be able to involve all willing volunteers. There will be a short meeting on **Monday 27th February at 3:30pm** for parents helping, to run through the risk assessment.
