## YEAR 5 TRIP TO THE SUTTON ECOLOGY CENTRE - 17<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> May 2021

This term, in their separate classes, Year 5 will be visiting the Sutton Ecology Centre. This is a great opportunity for the children to further their understanding of living things by pond dipping and exploring a natural habitat. The cost of this trip will be £5.60 per pupil.

Each class will go on a separate day/time as follows:

<b>5P</b>	Monday 17 <sup>th</sup> May 2021 - 10:00am to 12:00pm
<b>5J</b>	Monday 17 <sup>th</sup> May 2021 - 12:45pm to 14:45pm
<b>5S</b>	Monday 24 <sup>th</sup> May 2021 - 10:00am to 12:00pm

The sessions are half day for each class. The children will be travelling by foot leaving and returning during normal school hours.

**Children in 5J will ALL need to bring a packed lunch on the day of their trip as they will need to have their lunch slightly earlier on in the day.** Children in 5S and 5P will be able to have lunch at their normal time.

Children will need to bring with them the following items:

- Wear full SPJS PE kit including **SPJS school jumper and plain navy blue jogging bottoms**
- **Wear trainers;**
- a named water bottle;
- a warm coat
- sun-cream/sun-hat

Because these are only half day sessions, the children will need to come to school prepared as usual for a normal school day (pencil case, etc.).

Please make your payment of **£5.60 online via ParentPay by Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2021**. **By making your payment in this way you are giving consent for your child to take part.** This is a valuable experience that will fully support and add to your child's learning in the curriculum. Without continued parental support such trips would be unable to run. If you are able to help out with this trip, even if it is just to walk to and from the centre, please put a note in your child's home-school book by Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> May 2021.

We should point out that there are no funds available to cover the cost of pupils whose parents expect them to take part but who are unwilling or unable to contribute. If you have difficulty in affording this amount, please see the Headteacher privately. If insufficient voluntary contributions are received, the visit would have to be cancelled.
