Year 6 Trip to The Imperial War Museum – 20th & 22nd February 2023

On the 20th and 22nd February, Year 6 will be going to The Imperial War Museum in London to find out about the impact of World War II in Europe. This is a wonderful opportunity for the children to further their understanding of the causes, impact and turning points of a truly global conflict.

As the museum is unable to accommodate a group of 90, 6S will be split into two groups of 16. Half the children will travel to the museum on Monday 20th February with 6P and the other half with 6J on Wednesday the 22nd February. Children in 6S will have the date of their trip written in their home/school book today so you will know what day they are going. The children will be travelling by train, leaving school at 9.25 am and returning at approximately 3.30pm. Our museum visit will run from 11am to 2:30pm and the children will eat their lunch at the museum. As a result, all children will need to bring a **packed lunch** on the day.

Children are asked to wear school uniform, as normal, for this trip and will need to bring the following items with them:

- a packed lunch in a labelled plastic bag or school rucksack;
- a labelled and sealed water bottle;
- Clothing appropriate for the weather forecast for the day.

We will refer to the school's medical details to ensure medical needs are catered for, but if your child is prone to feeling travel sick or suffers from hayfever, please give them any medicine for this before they come into school and ensure their class teacher is aware. If your child requires a tablet for the return journey, please complete the following google form: <https://forms.gle/J9RaGLr1tqk3LQKs5> Please make sure that you bring any medication into the school office the day before the trip.

Both entrance to the Imperial War Museum and travel via TFL are free and as a result there is no need to make a payment for this visit. **We do still require consent for your child to go on this trip which can be given by completing the Google Form by Thursday 2nd February.** We would also appreciate any adult helpers so please also indicate this on the form. There will be a meeting for parent helpers on Monday 6th February to run through the risk assessment and details for the day.

This trip should prove to be an extremely valuable experience that will help the children to understand a challenging yet fascinating topic.
