PICK UP TIME

ACTIVITIES

GADGETS

Children may bring these into school on the day to use on the playground. Children should also bring a helmet with them to wear when they are using these in school to keep them safe. If you are happy for your child to take part in the activity without a helmet, and understand the risks involved with this, you will need to indicate this on the Google Form.

PICNIC ON THE FIELD AT LUNCHTIME

Children will have the opportunity to eat lunch on the field with their friends. Please can you provide your child with a packed lunch and possibly a blanket to sit on. If you would like your child to have a fizzy drink, that is absolutely fine (they requested this on their jamboard!).

SHIRT SIGNING

Children will have the opportunity to bring in an additional old school shirt, polo shirt or PE t-shirt and a permanent pen. The children will have the opportunity during their picnic to sign the shirts of their friends.

WATER PISTOL FUN - FEEL FREE TO COME AND WATCH FROM A DISTANCE!

For the last part of the afternoon (approx. 1.30pm) children will be able to take part in some water based fun! If your child has a super soaker/water pistol (the bigger the better) or even an empty squeezey bottle, then it would be great if they could bring this to join in with the fun.

Children will obviously get wet so may need a towel to wrap around them to go home or alternatively bring a change of clothes to put on afterwards. All children will be dismissed from the gates leading onto the field.

The children will receive a year book to commemorate their time at SPJS - thanks to the PTA for funding this and to Mrs Duggand and Mrs Curtis who spent a lot of time putting it together.
