

















Year 3 SPJS Curriculum Headlines

Below is an outline of what your child will be learning this week. To help you support your child, we have provided relevant website links as well as a brief summary of the learning outcomes.

Subject	What pupils will be learning
Reading/Writing 	<p>Writing: We will continue to read Diary of a Killer Cat as we consider another scenario where Tuffy might get himself into trouble. The children will plan and begin to write diary entries from Tuffy's perspective.</p> <p>Reading: We will continue to focus on our text about the Moomins as we RETRIEVE, INFER and make CHOICES.</p>

Maths 	<p>We will finish our Mass and Capacity unit then return to Fractions. We will revise how to add and subtract fractions then learn to calculate fractions of amounts.
