














## Year 3 SPJS Curriculum Headlines

Below is an outline of what your child will be learning this week. To help you support your child, we have provided relevant website links as well as a brief summary of the learning outcomes.

Subject	What pupils will be learning
<b>Reading/Writing</b> 	<p><b>Writing:</b> The children will write, edit and publish their diary entries from Tuffy's perspective. What mischief has he got up to?</p> <p><b>Reading:</b> Our DERIC sessions will focus on a non-fiction text about the Cube Houses in Rotterdam, Netherlands.</p>
<b>Spelling/ Vocabulary</b>	<p>We will revise adverbs and when they should be used. Our spelling focus is changing -le to -ly. This week's words to boost the children's vocabulary are:</p> <p> <b>Single chilli:</b> fume  <b>Double chilli:</b> trepidation <b>Topic:</b> range</p> <p>If your child would like to use Spelling Shed to support their spelling practice at home, their login details are in their HS Books. We have now set 2 tasks per week to help them revise the spelling rules we have already studied. They can also access the Common Exception Words by selecting More, My Lists and then selecting Stage 1 and 2 for the Y1/2 words and Stage 3 and 4 for the Y3/4 words. All tasks are optional but there if you wish to use them.</p>
<b>Maths</b> 	<p>Our fractions unit ends with fractions of amounts.
