<p>English</p> 	<p>Writing: As part of our unit on narrative writing we will move on to planning our own traditional tales on a story mountain. We will revise the past tense and the spelling rules for changing different verbs into past tense.</p> <p>Reading: We will be spending our lessons working on a Jubilee themed reading comprehension.</p>
<p>Spelling + Word of the Week</p>  <p>the Week</p>	<p>Children will have ten words to learn each week for a spelling test on Friday (Next week this will be on Thursday due to the bank holiday). These will be put on Spelling Shed for homework but please encourage spelling practice throughout the week.</p> <p>In our spelling lesson, we will explore words that make a 'k' sound spelt 'que' e.g. plaque, technique, unique. <p>Science</p> 	<p>To continue our Forces and Magnets topic, we will be learning more about magnetic and non-magnetic materials. We will create our own experiment to sort materials and record our results.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>We will be learning more about digital time, particularly 24 hour digital clocks. In order to do this, we will be matching analogue times with digital times. Please could you discuss times of the day at home e.g 'We're having dinner, what time is it?' to help children understand the chronology of their day.</p>
<p>Foundation Subjects</p> 	<p>Geography: We will be researching Brighton and comparing it to our local area.</p> <p>Jubilee Day: Please check your email about all the exciting things we are doing on Thursday 26th to celebrate Her Majesty, The Queen's, Diamond Jubilee.</p>
<p>Health and Fitness</p> 	<p>In gymnastics we will travel across benches dismounting with a shape jump. We will be aiming to show control throughout.</p>
