Subject	What pupils will be learning
<p>Reading & Writing</p> 	<p>Writing: We will continue to be inspired by <i>The Bear & The Piano</i> as we develop our descriptive writing. <p>Maths</p> 	<p>This week, in place value, we will place numbers on a numberline, order and compare numbers and consider the patterns we see when we add or subtract 1, 10 or 100.</p> <p>🏰 TTRS - Click Here</p>
<p>Health and Fitness</p>	<p>Tuesday: Games outside - Multiskills</p> <p>Thursday: We will begin to explore our 'Savannah Dance' topic.</p>
