<p>English</p> 	<p>Writing: Now we have looked at the way that a letter is set out and the type of language used in them, we will be working towards planning and writing our very own letters to Santa.</p> <p>Reading: This week, we will be hearing children read and sharing stories together, along with recommending books to one another.</p>
