Return to school for all students - 8th March 2021

I hope that you managed to have a safe and relaxing half-term. I'm sure you will have heard the announcement from the Prime Minister outlining the 'roadmap out of lockdown'. We are delighted that we are now able to welcome back all pupils to school on Monday 8th March.

Over the last few months, we have all been experiencing a lot of changes in our lives. I think we would all agree that circumstances are certainly different at the moment. Thinking back to the end of the autumn term when we all said goodbye to each other at Christmas, we were looking forward to a better 2021. Things certainly did not go to plan. However, we will be reunited again and look forward to a positive rest of the year.
